


WHARTON CERTIFICATE IN MANAGEMENT

Law School students are awarded a Wharton Certificate in Management upon completion of a custom-designed, one-semester course open to all 2L and 3L students.

- Creating Competitive Advantage

The Wharton Certificate in Management is the first-of-its-kind in the country offered by a top law school. It prepares students to manage and lead in a wide array of contexts – government and non-profits, as well as large firms and businesses.
